Remember	Find out the names of the countries that were part of the Allied Forces. Write a mnemonic (a saying using the first letter of the country's name as the first letter of the word in the saying) to help you remember them all.	Find out about Winston Churchill and create a fact sheet or presentation about it.
Understand	Understand how rations worked on the Front. What do they eat? How do they cook? How was food divided.	Understand what an evacuation is. Why was this vitally important? How would an evacuee have felt during this time? Write a letter from their point of view.
